Karl Hasslinger is a retired US Navy officer with extensive undersea warfare and defense strategy experience. These experiences include command of an attack submarine, Fellow on the Chief of Naval Operations Strategic Studies Group, Strategic Planning Assistant to the Director of Submarine Warfare on the Chief of Naval Operations staff, and as Senior

Military Assistant in the Office of the Secretary of Defense - Net Assessment.

Prior to joining Telemus, Mr. Hasslinger served as General Dynamics Electric Boat's Director of Washington Operations where he was responsible for strategic analysis, government relations, business development, and ballistic missile defense activities. During his fifteen-year tenure he helped develop strategies to increase the Virginia-class submarine acquisition rate, win approval for the Virginia Payload Module, approval for the Columbia-class ballistic missile submarine, and for a new submarine payload development program. While at Electric Boat, Mr. Hasslinger was also an active participant in Department of Defense wargames, and he conceived and implemented the Submarines 2050 Group Innovation Seminar series that examined future undersea warfare capabilities and requirements and concepts for the next attack submarine.

Mr. Hasslinger is a graduate of the Navy's Nuclear Propulsion program and he completed the MIT Seminar XXI course in Foreign Politics, International Relations, and the National Interest. He is also a graduate of the US Naval War College where he earned a Master of Science in National Security and Strategic Studies, graduating with Highest Distinction.
